

Platinum-100A-V3:

- The tricolor (WRB) cable here is the throttle cable (WHITE: throttle signal wire, RED: BEC output wire, BLACK: ground wire);
- The bicolor (RB) cable here is the BEC cable (RED: BEC output wire, BLACK: ground wire);
- Hence, there are 2 Black wires & 2 Red wires are connected in parallel to the output end of the BEC to make the higher current get through;
- The thin Orange wire is for RPM signal output;
- The 3-pin port (marked with + P) is an independent port for parameter setting; it can connect LCD Program Box, or be the output port of the ESC running status data. 2 pins corresponding to "+" & "-" in the program port are also connected to the output end of the built-in BEC, so that it can power the cooling fan of the ESC.
